Sex & Dating

- Casual dating is less common given emphasis on dating as a precursor to marriage.
- PDA is frowned upon in traditional culture, this has changed especially in cities
- Many universities discourage pre-marital sex

Alcohol & Drugs

- Legal age to buy/consume alcohol: 18
 - Very social drinking culture
 - It may be perceived as rude to not finish your drink or at least try it when offered.
- All drugs and usage are strictly prohibited

LGBTQIA+ Culture

- Same sex relationships and activity is legal but continued censorship, surveillance, and discrimination exists towards LGBTQ people.
- Specific LGBTQ communities and neighborhoods exist in major cities

- Population: 1.4 billion
