## Country:

Hong Kong (HK)

### Sex & Dating

- There is a noticeable divide between Hong Kong locals and foreigners with dating.
- Casual dating is a relatively new concept
- Under HK law, rape can only be committed by a man upon a woman.

### Alcohol & Drugs

- Legal age to buy/consume alcohol: 18
  - Relaxed and permissive drinking culture.
- Zero tolerance policy against illegal drug use.
  - Illegal drug use can result in hefty fines and can include seven years of imprisonment.

### LGBTQIA+ Culture

- Same sex relationships and activity is legal
- There are no laws censoring LGBTQIA topics and public discussion or promotion of them.
- No explicit restrictions on LGBTQIA rights, overall decline of civil rights in Hong Kong
- PDA is not illegal, but is frowned upon by traditional Chinese culture.

### Cultural Customs and Norms

- Population: 7.4 million
- Currency: Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)
- Official Language: English, Chinese
  - Cantonese is the most commonly spoken language; about half of people speak some level of English and/or Mandarin.
  - If you have been invited to someone's place, bring a small gift
