Morocco (MA)

### Sex & Dating

- MA is a constitutional monarchy with conservative cultural norms
  - Traditional gender roles still very present
- Men and women may not be alone together, public displays of affection is discouraged
  - Greetings are often formal with a right hand over heart rather than a handshake

### Alcohol & Drugs

- Legal age to buy/consume alcohol: 18
  - Alcohol is prohibited in Islamic culture, the purchase of such is culturally taboo
  - Bars are primarily frequented by Westerners, public intoxication is illegal
- Possession of most drugs, particularly cannabis, is illegal and harshly prosecuted

### LGBTQIA+ Culture

- Same-sex relationships are illegal and punishable by fine or imprisonment
- Limited safe social spaces for LGBTQ communities

### Cultural Customs and Norms

- Population: 37 million
- Currency: Dirham
- Official Language: Arabic
  - Standard Amazigh peoples/language and French are also widely spoken depending on region
- Islam is big part of culture
- Distribution of religious material is illegal
