South Africa (ZA)

Sex & Dating

- South Africa's law protects gender equality
- Communication is typically informal, similar to dating although gender roles may still be present
- Be attentive and sensitive to colonial and apartheid legacies in political discussions

Alcohol & Drugs

- Legal age to buy/consume alcohol: 18
 - Current policy debate over whether to change age to 21
- Cannabis (marijuana) use is technically legal for adults in private settings although can carry punishable fines / jail for "inappropriate" use

LGBTQIA+ Culture

- ZA is, to date, the only African country to legalize same-sex relations
- LGBTQ rights are guaranteed
- Prominent LGBTQ scenes in urban cities
