2021 ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS



Purpose and Eligibility

The **Dante Alighieri Society of Denver** established a scholarship program in 1985 to assist qualified students in advancing their study of the Italian language and culture through study-abroad programs in Italy. They are one-time, non-renewable awards.

In order to be granted an award, the student must be accepted in an established study-abroad program in Italy and successfully submit the following by **April 3, 2021**:

- 1. A completed application form.
- 2. A personal essay.
- 3. An official college transcript.
- 4. A detailed description of your proposed study-abroad program and a letter of acceptance to the program.
- 5. A financial worksheet.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must come from an Italian language instructor.

Selection of winners will be made on the basis of quality of their essay, prior studies of the Italian language, academic performance (GPA), length and quality of their proposed study-abroad program, non-academic activities, financial need and letters of recommendation.
