

# HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

- \* Do you meet the program's minimum eligibility requirements?
  - GPA
  - Language and/ or course prerequisites
  - -Additional requirements (meeting with OIE Advisor etc)
- \* Do your studies at DU match the preferred or required area(s) of study?
- \* Are your essay questions thoughtful, well-written, and do they clearly demonstrate the following?:
  - 1. Articulate why you have selected your program choice(s)
  - 2. Exhibit that you have researched and understand the program(s)' structure and academic offerings
  - 3. Communicate academic, personal, and professional goals for your study abroad experience and how your program choice(s) fit in with those goals
  - 4. Show how your program choice(s) build upon your academics here at DU and how you plan to continue to build upon your program experience upon your return from abroad
- GPA, preferred areas of study, overall academic/extracurricular fit, prior coursework completed, and student conduct records may all be considered.

# **YOUR DU NOMINATION**

- ♦ Deadline for ALL applications for 2017-2018 Year is January 20th
  - Fall, Winter or Spring Study Abroad (Limited Year Long Options)
  - **† UPP students must submit their Petition Supplement by Jan 6**
- Find out where you've been nominated at Global Gala (Feb 17)

# Once YOU'VE BEEN NOMINATED BY DU

- **♦ Must Respond to Nomination Email in allotted time**
- Must Complete Program-specific application which will be submitted to your program by the deadlines set by DU

# LOOKING AHEAD

### THE PROGRAM APPLICATION (after nomination)

- ♦ Do not submit a program application until you receive a nomination from DU to apply to the program!
- ♦ You will have 2-4 weeks to submit the program application
  - ♦ If the program application is late, you may forfeit your spot!
  - ♦ Become familiar with program—specific application(s)- know how much time this will take you
  - ♦ Some programs require letter(s) of recommendation- talk to potential references soon!
