**If permitted by the study abroad program, students may be allowed to re-sit an exam (remotely at DU or at the host university) after the completion date of the program and in compliance with the academic policies of the study abroad program. In those instances, all exams must be completed either one year after the end date of the study abroad program or before the student's DU graduation date, whichever is earlier. Grades issued with an equivalent "incomplete" will be processed as "F" until a new transcript is issued with a grade per the above timeline.

GRADE SCALES—AFRICA

Ghana

ISEP: University of Ghana

The University of Ghana uses the equivalent of U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. Other grades such as I (Incomplete), X (Fail, F), Z (Disqualification) or Y (Continuing) will be converted to an F in the DU system.

Madagascar

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Morocco

ISA Meknes

ISA converts credits and grades into U.S. semester credits and letter grades. To determine DU quarter credits from semester credits, multiply the credits by 1.5. If contact hours are provided instead of semester credits, divide hours by 10 to determine quarter credits. Use letter grades as listed.

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Senegal

MSID

MSID uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

South Africa

ISA Programs

ISA converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester and quarter credits. If looking at semester credits, multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. When looking at ISA listed instructional hours, 10 hours is equivalent to 1 DU credit.

South Africa Universities may use different credit scales.

University of Cape Town

DU uses ISA's recommended credit conversion and grades for UCT:

- 15 UCT HEQF = 2.5 U.S. Semester Credits/ 3.75 DU credits
- 18 UCT HEQF = 3 U.S. Semester Credits / 4.5 DU credits
- 24 UCT HEQF = 4 U.S. Semester Credits / 6 DU credits
- 30 UCT HEQF= 5 U.S. Semester credits / 7.5 DU credits
- 36 UCT HEQF = 6 U.S. Semester Credits / 9 DU credits

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Uganda

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

GRADE SCALES—AMERICAS

Argentina

IFSA Butler: Argentine Universities program

IFSA Butler converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

ISA: University of Belgrano

ISA converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

SSA: National University of Cordoba

SSA converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Bolivia

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Brazil

ISA: University do Sul of Santa Catarina

ISA converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Canada

Canadian universities (Montreal and Ottawa) use the US grading system as well as US semester credits. To change to quarter credits, multiply by 1.5. (per Dr. Beaudoin).

Course Load and Credit Equivalency

A full load for a typical Montreal student is five courses per term. However, if students wish to take only four courses per term, you would need to check with your academic advisor at the University of Montreal. Each course generally equates to a three-credit semester course in the US system.

At Ottawa most students usually take 4-5 courses, with each course being approximately 3 semester hours.

Chile

IFSA Butler: Valparaiso Universities program

IFSA Butler converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

ISA: University Adolfo Ibañez

ISA converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. Service Learning (optional add on) may be listed as US semester credit--Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Costa Rica

IFSA Butler: National University

IFSA Butler converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

ISA: Veritas University

ISA converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. Service Learning may be listed as US semester credit--Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

SFS: Sustainable Development Studies

SFS uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Cuba

IFSA Butler: University of Havana

As a new DU Partner Program, we have not yet received an official transcript from IFSA Butler—University of Havana. Please contact your OIE advisor for information on how credits & grades might transfer to DU.

Dominican Republic

CIEE: Santiago- Liberal Arts & Service-Learning

DU uses CIEE's recommended credit and letter grade conversions. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Ecuador

MSID

MSID uses U.S. semester credits and U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Mexico

IFSA Butler: Autonomous University of the Yucatan

IFSA Butler converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Panama

SFS: Tropical Island Biodiversity and Conservation Studies

SFS uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Peru

IFSA Butler: Pontifical Catholic University

IFSA Butler converts the credits and grades into U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Puerto Rico

SSA: University of the Sacred Heart

As a new DU Partner Program, we have not yet received an official transcript from SSA—University of the Sacred Heart. Please contact your OIE advisor for information on how credits & grades might transfer to DU.

Turks and Caicos

SFS: Marine Resource Studies

SFS uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

China

China Studies Institute

China Studies Institute uses U.S. semester credits and grades as U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

CIEE Programs

CIEE uses U.S. semester credits and grades as U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

g-MEO Chengdu American Center for Study Abroad

g-MEO uses U.S. semester credits and grades as U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

University of Hong Kong

1 HKU credit is equal to 1 DU credit. HKU grades are reported on the US A-F scale.

India

IFSA/Alliance: The City, The River, The Sacred

Alliance uses U.S. semester credits and grades as U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

AIFS: University of Hyderabad

University of Hyderabad credits and grades are equivalent to U.S. semester credits and grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Japan

Akita International University

Akita International uses U.S. semester credits and U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Waseda University

Waseda credits are in U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits.

Waseda uses letter grades, but their letter system is not the same as a US system. The grade conversion is below.

ISA: Korea University - STEM, Business, Social Sciences & Liberal Arts

Mongolia

SIT Programs

SIT uses U.S. letter grades and U.S. semester credits. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Thailand

CIS Mahidol University

Mahidol uses U.S. grades and U.S. trimester credits. To convert the trimester credits, there is a two-step process: Multiply trimester credits by .75 to convert to U.S. semester credits. Then, multiply by 1.5 to get quarter credits. For example, a 4 credit course at Mahidol would be 3 US semester credits. DU quarter credits would be 4.5.

International Sustainable Development Studies Institute (ISDSI)

ISDSI uses U.S. semester credits and grades as U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

MSID

MSID uses U.S. semester credits and U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

Vietnam

CET uses U.S. semester credit credits and grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

GRADE SCALES—EUROPE

Austria

AIFS: Salzburg

You will receive a transcript from this program's school of record, the University of Richmond. Credits will be listed as US semester credits. Multiply by 1.5 to determine DU quarter credits. Grades will be listed in US letter grades so no conversion is necessary.

If hours and dates of instructions are provided instead of semester credits, multiply hours per week by the number of weeks and divide by 10 to determine DU quarter credits (e.g., 3 hours per week x 15 weeks ÷ 10 = 4.5 DU credits). DU only counts full weeks of instruction and does *not* round up the number of weeks.

Cyprus

Global Semesters – University of Nicosia

Grades are in the U.S. system and remain the same. For ECTS credits multiply by 0.8 to get DU quarter credits.

Czech Republic

ISA: Charles University

ISA converts credits and grades into U.S. semester credits and letter grades. To determine DU quarter credits from semester credits, multiply the credits by 1.5. If contact hours are provided instead of semester credits, divide hours by 10 to determine quarter credits. Use letter grades as listed.

ISA: University of Economics

ISA converts credits and grades into U.S. semester credits and letter grades. To determine DU quarter credits from semester credits, multiply the credits by 1.5. If contact hours are provided instead of semester credits, divide hours by 10 to determine quarter credits. Use letter grades as listed.

ISEP: Masaryk University

Czech universities award credits called “ECTS” that are each worth 0.8 DU credits; they utilize a six point grading system outlined below. DU uses the ISEP grade conversion scale for Masaryk to convert EU/ECTS letter grades to US letter grades.

Transcripts that list F followed by an additional letter grade, indicate that a student failed the first exam and then re-sat the exam and received the subsequent grade listed. DU will use the second grade provided for the re-sat exam. An asterisk (*) in place of a grade indicates an incomplete and will be an F.

*Students may only receive these grade conversions if letter grades (A-F) are not available for the course, otherwise letter grades (A-F) are required.

ISA: EuroScholars – Europe

ISA will not necessarily provide a cover letter. Please contact ISA directly with questions. Credits may appear in ECTS (multiply by 0.8 to get DU quarter credits) or in contact hours (divide by 10 to get DU quarter credits). See country listed for suggested grade conversions that DU is likely to use. If you are at a EuroScholar University that DU has not previously received a transcript from, exact credit and grade conversions will be determined once your transcript is received and can be reviewed by the OIE.

France

Depending upon your program, your abroad transcript will:

*award credits called “ECTS” that are each worth 0.8 DU credits. This will usually be for Sciences Po Rennes and the University of Lille.

*award credit using contact hours. This is usually ISA Paris. Divide by 10 for a DU credit.

*award credit using the U.S. semester system (IAU, API Caen). Each credit you earn abroad is worth 1.5 DU credits.

In all cases, some academic departments at DU limit the amount of credit that you can transfer back for your major from abroad. Speak with your major academic advisor about any credit restrictions that exist.

IAU uses U.S. semester credits and U.S. letter grades. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get DU quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

IFE Programs (in Paris, Strasbourg, and Brussels, Belgium)

IFE uses US letter grades and US semester credits. (Ask IFE for their recommended US Semester conversions.) Multiply by 1.5 to get DU quarter credits and use letter grades as listed.

ISA Catholic University Paris

ISA Catholic Paris uses contact hours. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine DU quarter credits. Use the grade conversion scale above.

USAC Lyon

Students who participate on USAC Lyon's program will receive a US transcript from one of the Member Universities. Classes will be graded on an A-F academic scale. Credits will appear in US semester credits, multiply by 1.5 to get DU quarter credits. (While abroad, use the aforementioned contact hour/ECTS credit calculations as a guide, however the University of Idaho, the Member University, has the final say with calculating the U.S. transcript.)

Sciences Po Rennes

Sciences Po Rennes uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Multiply ECTS by .8 to get DU quarter credits. Use the grade conversion scale above.

Germany

Free University Berlin (FU-BEST)

FU-Berlin transcripts list credits in contact hours. Divide contact hours by 10 to get DU quarter credits.

Classes in English: Use full reported contact hours. 15 contact hours per 1 US semester credit. US semester credit X 1.5= DU credit.
- **Vladivostok State University of Economics and Service:** 5=A; 4=B; 3=C; 2=D; 1=F. Russian grades rarely include + or -. Classes listed in contact hours. General rule from SRAS: Language classes: Use .75 of total contact hours reported to reflect accuracy of actual class time. Classes in English: Use full reported contact hours. 15 contact hours per 1 US semester credit. US semester credit X 1.5= DU credit.
- **Eurasian Linguistic Institute:** 5=A; 4=B; 3=C; 2=D; 1=F. Russian grades rarely include + or -. Occasionally, grades will be received on a US A-F scale. Classes listed in contact hours. General rule from SRAS: Language classes: Use .75 of total contact hours reported to reflect accuracy of actual class time. Classes in English: Use full reported contact hours. 15 contact hours per 1 US semester credit. US semester credit X 1.5= DU credit.

Spain

Academic Language Institute

ALI converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. Please note that No presentado = F.

CIEE: Alicante – Liberal Arts

DU uses CIEE's recommended credit and letter grade conversions. Multiply semester credits by 1.5 to get quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed.

IFE Program (Asturias)

IFE uses US letter grades and US semester credits. (Ask IFE for their recommended US Semester conversions.) Multiply by 1.5 to get DU quarter credits and use letter grades as listed.

ISA Programs

ISA converts grades into U.S. grades. Divide contact hours by 10 to determine quarter credits, and use letter grades as listed. Please note that No presentado = F.

ISA: University of Sevilla - Hispanic Studies & Electives

Students who opt for the early Spanish intensive course as part of the ISA University of Sevilla program will receive a transcript from Universidad Internacional Menéndez Pelayo.
